

Target Frame Placement

Below are a few items we would like to bring to every members' attention:

Short Range Berm (SRB) - The SRB has only two official positions to place fames. Each approved location can be identified by the PVC frame holders buried in the ground. The height of the frame can be adjusted by moving the pin to the appropriate hole in order to ensure your round hits the berm properly. Additionally steel targets can be placed directly at or in the berm if needed.





50 Yard Range (50 yrd) - The 50 yrd range only two official positions to place fames. Each approved location can be identified by the PVC frame holders buried in the ground, one at 25 yrds and one at 50 yrds. When using the 50 yrd berm location, ensure there are no frames standing at the 25 yrd position. Just gently place the unused frame on the ground so no unnecessary damage is inflicted.



Trying to shoot through the 25 yrd frame to a target on the 50 yrd frame is not permitted. All too often the shooter will end up hitting the 25 yrd frame, hence inflicting unnecessary damage to the frame. Again, just gently place the unused frame on the ground so no unnecessary damage is inflicted.

Lastly, all frames are mark at the top to identify where they are meant to be placed. Please ensure you use the current frame at the correct location. All ASC members are asked to not shoot the frames if possible.

Spring Work Party

There will be a massive spring cleaning and maintenance work party on Sunday May 22 at 10:00. We will tackling the following work:

- Pressure washing the outside of the restroom building.
- Blowing out and cleaning both the 50-yard and 100-meter ranges.
- Pressure washing both ranges.
- Cleaning and sealing both ranges' roofs.
- Repainting the red safety lines
- Sealing the wall between the ranges (if enough members show)
- General range and grounds clean up to include the trash immediately outside the gate.

We will need:

- Ladders (both step and extension)
- Gas powered pressure washers (2 to 3)
- · Garden hose
- Telescoping poles for sealing the roofs. (We have the brushes and adaptors)
- Gas/battery powered leaf blowers
- Telescopic pressure washer wands for use on the roofs.
- Tools to facilitate safely removing the trash by the gate. There may be reptilian inhabitants.

So come out and get your service hours in and make your club look a little better. Both ranges will be closed from 10:00 until the work is complete. This is a fair-weather work party. ASC Gate Combination Will Change Saturday, May 21st

The ASC gate combination will be changed after the May Board of Directors meeting. The new badges have been mailed out to members who have paid their renewal invoice and provided updated NRA if necessary. If you have not seen your renewal, please check your junk folder. If your NRA is marked expired, please email the Secretary, secretary@airfieldshootingclub.org, a copy of your current NRA card or NRA magazine label. Renewal Due Date You will have until June 1st to pay your membership dues and other costs owed to ASC. If you pay your membership dues after June 1st through August 31st there will be a penalty fee of \$25.00. After September 1st, you will be required to re-join the club. This will include attending new member orientation, reviewing club rules and regulations, and paying owed back dues as well as the \$50.00 initiation fee.


For those who might not know, the American Rimfire Association was started in April 1988 by a group of .22LR shooters who wanted competitive .22LR benchrest competition, matches, consistent scoring and a means for maintaining shooter statistics. American Rimfire Association has grown since then promoting clubs, expanded competitions across the United States offering matches and tournaments to anyone interested in precision .22LR bench rest shooting.

Airfield Shooting Club wishes to gauge the interest in friendly .22LR shooting benchrest match for the club members, your family and/or friends. If interest is high ASC may promote more events throughout the year.

The matches will follow a modified rule set for this fun event outlined below. Each participant will compete in a .22LR timed relay style shooting match using ARA style targets from a bench rest at the 50-yard line. The number of relays (2 to 6 relays) will depend on the number of shooters participating. Look for the Rimfire Match link under the Club Program section on our website. A registration fee may apply.
